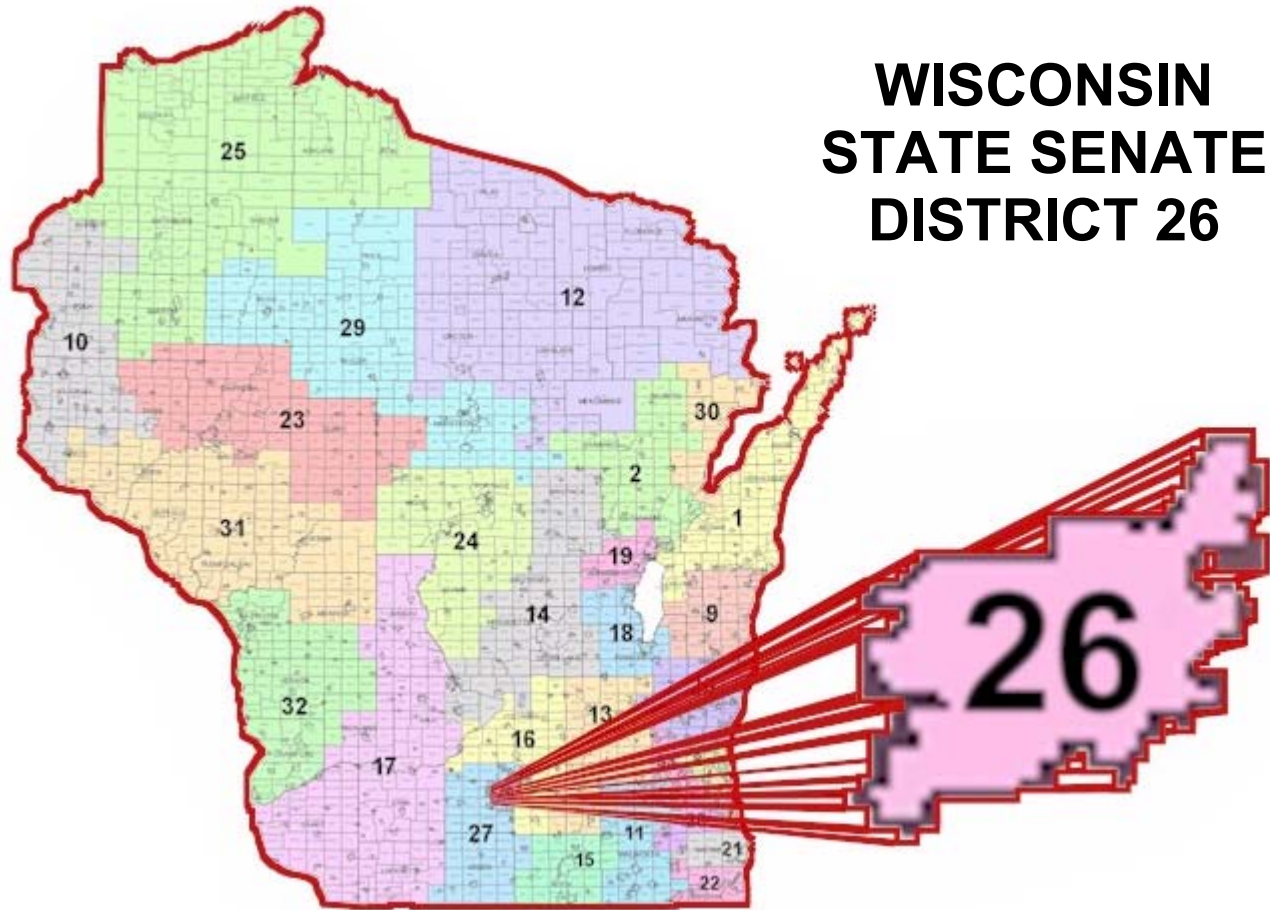




UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN SYSTEM ECONOMIC IMPACT



WISCONSIN STATE SENATE DISTRICT 26

In fiscal 2002, the UW System generated nearly \$9.5 billion of economic impact on the Wisconsin economy. That impact in turn generated 150,000 in-state jobs and \$408 million in state tax revenue. The economic benefit of the UW System impacts every senate district. Within Senate District 26, the overall economic impact of the UW System is \$2,582,238,256. This economic activity generated 44,837 in-state jobs and tax revenue of \$127,997,587.
